
As formal bedding schemes continue to dwindle, we must be proactive in finding cost effective, more sustainable alternatives. While perennials are beautiful in summer, we all value the vibrant flush of colour that only spring bulbs can bring. In 1999, we brought our bulb-planting machine over from Holland, and planted the first ever mechanically planted bulb in grass in the UK. Seventeen years and several million bulbs later, we rarely plant single species. Most of the projects we are involved in prefer to plant different mixtures for various purposes. Please see the table on page 25 to help you make your choice.

As well as our "normal" planting machine for planting vast swathes on relatively level ground, we have been using for a few years now, a special machine for planting on embankments or steeper slopes. Now for the first time in the UK & Ireland, we are offering the services of our "side mounted planter" it is especially useful when planting between rows of trees, making a neat and tide job in confined spaces. You can see pictures of this on page 29.

Whether you are a project needing a few Million bulbs planted by machine, or an "In Bloom" or community group who needs a few hundred bulbs to plant on a Sunday morning, we are here to help. As a special services to smaller groups, we have superb quality, long handled bulb planting tools for sale that you can have delivered with your bulbs. They are especially useful for planting "In the green" as well as dry bulbs in un-cultivated ground. See page 31 for details.

"Working together to achieve more"

Planting bulbs is a fun and simple activity for everyone! By planting bulbs with volunteers, it is easy to create a sense of connection within the community, with each other, and with their natural environment.

Also at sites that are not accessible for our planting machine, it may still be possible to plant the bulbs manually.

Note: We can help you in the design and implementation of your projects.

Think about:

- creating awareness of the activity,
- use of social media to promote the event,
- advice and guidance with the planting to be done by members of the public.







For many years, our biodiversity has been under pressure. Many species of bees and butterflies are threatened with extinction. A worrying situation, because these insects are very important for the pollination of many plants and the preservation of the environment.

One reason why many bees die prematurely is the shortage of available food. Bees need to find enough food in early spring. Different varieties of flower bulbs bloom from early spring (February) and are very good suppliers of nectar. By planting these bee-attractive bulb varieties, we can help the bees in their search for food.

Butterflies also need food. Awakening from their hibernation at the end of spring or summer, summer flowering bulbs are a great food source for them. We have made a combination of bulb species that flower after one another. This has resulted in mixtures that encourage biodiversity.

Bee Surprise mix



Bees love this mixture. Based on our original bees/ biodiversity mix, we have added two more varieties of tulips to end the mix in an explosion of red and yellow.











Bee S Kal Mix (Organic)



Organic flower bulbs support the creation of a healthy environment. By the use of natural means to combat pest and diseases, organic bulb production creates a healthy source of food for all pollinators. To encourage the use of organic bulbs, we are promoting them in an organic bulb program with the help of SKAL (the European control organisation for biological products) and in cooperation with biological beekeepers and Dutch, organic bulb growers.

As part of this program, we offer our Bee S Kal Mix. This bulb mixture consists of 100% organically grown bulbs and will help butterflies and bees to find more "healthy calories".







Bees/Biodiversity Mix



Our specially developed Bees Mix consists of a number of bulbs that meet the need of bees and butterflies (including Crocus, Chionodoxa, Scilla, Muscari and naturalizing Tulips).











Blushing Mix



This mix starts with yellow crocus, followed by purple crocus and finally 'blush' with Tulips Pulchella violacea and Chionodoxa.





Brilliant mix





By mixing daffodils with tulipa sylvestris and Alliums, we have created a long flowering mix that is great for butterflies.












Butterfly Mix



This special Butterfly mix meets the food needs of butterflies during spring and summer season. The mix includes Camassia, Nectaroscordum and Allium. These varieties bloom in May, June, July. As this mixture is quite tall, it is particularly suitable for using in low maintenance locations or in combination with low growing shrubs.

Colour Festival is a wonderful combination of Crocus, naturalizing Tulips, Chionodoxa and Narcissus. A unique combination of Colours which creates a Festival to look at!







Double Pleasure Mix



As one of our first mixes that we created, Double Pleasure continues to be one of our most popular mixes. A combination of early yellow, and late white flowering dwarf narcissi, it remains incredible value in terms of £/m per week of flowering display.







Daffodils Mixtures



Daffodils are available in many varieties and colours and Forms, not only plain yellow, but White, Orange, and Pink, with many combinations of petal and trumpet colours. Not only do we offer standard "Naturalising", Trumpet", "Woodland" Mixes, but we can offer you beautiful bespoke mixtures that are made according to your specification. For the best results, follow these 3 simple steps: Don't plant under trees, or where the soil may become too dry. Plant at the correct depth; 4-6 inches. Don't cut the leaves off until they are completely brown. With the correct site choice, and aftercare, Daffodils can last a lifetime.







Lubbe's Pride Mix



A mixture with a more 'ecological' look is our Lubbe's Pride Mix. Bulbous plants like Snowdrops, Bluebells, Crocus, Snakeshead, etc. provide a surprisingly good effect in your surroundings. With a flowering period from February till May you can enjoy the results of the specially selected bulbs for a long period.











Pick your own mixtures



To create more community involvement in the maintenance of public open spaces, we came up with the idea to introduce pick-your-own-mixtures. By "offering" the local people their own flower borders, where they are able to help themselves to a bunch of flowers for their home, they are much more committed to take care of their environment.







Mix 4Pleasure



Building on the foundations of the reliable Double Pleasure mix, we added Cammassia and Purple Allium to further extend the flowering period. The benefits are 2 fold, being friendly towards Butterflies, and extending the colourful period whilst the Narcissi leaves are feeding the bulbs below ground, ensuring continued flowering for future years.











Extreme Flower Mix



To meet the demand for a flowerbulb mixture-as-long-aspossible, we have added Crocuses to the mixture 'Mix 4Pleasure'. This has resulted in a bloom from February to June.







The 3 Musketeers Mix



A very simple, but beautifully effective mix. 3 Musketeers begins with Yellow Crocus, as they fade away, Blue Chionodoxa take over, ending with a fabulous display of Scented Narcissus Thalia.









Winter to Summer Mix



This long season mix is a beautiful mix of yellow Narcissus varieties and Camassia followed up by Alliums. We have created a selection of Narcissus varieties which flower consecutively. This generates an extraordinary flush of colour, for 6 months.

** Our popular "Verge Mix" is a variation of Winter to Summer Mix", and includes different colours of Daffodils that generate a long flowering Mix.







Verge Mix



This mix is an update of our Winter to Summer Mix. Instead of just yellow daffodils, we mixed a variety of colours. Flowering period is from January until June.

Cutting policy: We are often asked the question: "When can we mow the dying foliage?"



Our answer to that is simple: For best results when the foliage is brown (dead). As soon as the foliage is brown and you can pull it loose from the bulb without much force, you can mow it. The reason to wait until it is brown is that the juice flow has stopped and no "open wounds" in the plant are caused by mowing. These "open wounds" could otherwise become entry points for fungi and bacteria. The sooner you cut off the foliage after flowering, the less flowers you will get the following year. Repeated early mowing will result in no flowers at best, and in the worst-case scenario, the bulbs will eventually die.

Wildflowers

Our wildflower meadows are created, using Perennial native species, either with or without wild species of grass.

The benefit of using these mixtures is that after the first season, they will flower for several years to come. By adapting to your local soil and weather conditions, some species will thrive, and others will not. The meadow that you will have in 3-5 years, will be unique to your area, and will contain the species that prefer to grow in your soil. If you have a heavy clay soil, your meadow will look very different to the meadow sown on a free draining soil.

There are various options to consider when choosing a flower meadow.

Wildflower meadow or Urban meadow?



The disadvantage of using a perennial mix is: Takes a full season growth to establish the perennial plants before they start to flower. – To resolve this issue, we can also combine a "Cornfield Annual" mix as a "nurse crop" to give you that first year flush of colour.

May be perceived to be less colourful, or full of weeds. Well, beauty is in the eye of the beholder. Yes, the flowers are generally subtle in colour, and some of the species in the mix, may well be weeds, but only on sites where they are not supposed to be.



Urban meadows

Our urban meadows are generally Annuals, and a made up of various mixes of bright, colourful species, to give a long flowering display through the summer months into autumn, and even the first frosts.

The benefit of using these mixtures is that they are generally very reliable, and will flower profusely only a few weeks after sowing. There is a very wide choice of colour schemes, to choose from, and all are very good for Biodiversity. You may also choose a different mix each year to bring some variation to your environment.

The disadvantages are:

More expensive than Wildflowers, as they generally need to be re sown each year.

It is possible, that by using the same plots each year, a weed seed bank may build up, and weeds such as fat hen, or the often used Corn Marigold, may spoil the display after a few years.

Machine Planting There are many reasons why our clients use our service; mechanical planting:

- It saves time, so that one can focus to other activities
- Less labour costs
- Always correct planting depth
- By planting bulbs along roads, less delays because machine planting is quicker.

We are able to offer you the services of three types of planting machines. With these machines, it is possible to plant bulbs among grass, in open ground, on embankments and between trees.

Machine planter

Is able to lift the turf, plant the bulbs and replace the turf in one single pass. Suitable for planting in open ground. Preferably firm, uncultivated soil. Plants a 1 m wide continuous band of bulbs. 1.6 m wide access required.







Roots permitting, with this planter we are able to plant very close to the tree trunk. This is possible because the planting foot is mounted on the side of the machine. Extremely useful when planting on a boulevard of trees.







Embankment planter

Specially designed for working on embankments up to 30-35 degrees. Very useful on locations where it is not possible/difficult to mow the grass. By using long flowering mixtures of bulbs it will reduce the routine cuts throughout the mowing season.



Fertilizer

It is important to add fertilizer to your planted bulbs to get the best, long-term results.

New to our machine planting programme is the option of direct fertiliser application to the root zone. We use a 100% organic DCM ECO-slow release mix, which meets all the nutritional requirements required for many years of successful flowering. To achieve this, we use a small applicator, which is mounted on the front of the planting machine (see photo).

For improved flowering over many years, it may also be necessary to feed flower bulbs every year or every other year. Best results will be obtained when you do this at different times of the year, especially when your soil is sandy or very free draining.

In this case, we recommended using 2 kg fertiliser per 100 m2 of general NPK fertiliser; 13-13-20 will be fine.





If your bulbs stop flowering, it will almost certainly be due to one of the following reasons:

- Flowers/leaves cut down too early: Try to make sure that all leaves have turned yellow, or if possible completely died before you cut them down.
- Soil too dry: Avoid planting directly under large trees, or shallow soil. If the bulbs cannot feed and drink, they will not try to reproduce.
- Nutrient imbalance: High Nitrogen in the soil due to grass clippings being left behind promotes strong, lush growth of both grass and bulbs, but bulbs fail to flower. To address this we recommend Straight Potash application, either Sulphate or Murate of Potash, applied as soon as the problem is spotted. In our experience, this helps in two ways, promotes "hard, mature" growth of the bulbs under the ground, at the same time as reducing tall, lush, grass growth above ground, which enables the bulb foliage to access more sunlight, thus healthier growth.

In our experience, following the above simple steps will bring you many years of trouble free enjoyment.

Storage of flowerbulbs

If your flowerbulbs arrive before you are ready to plant, it is important to open the boxes and store the bulbs in a cool and dry area, away from extremes of heat or cold, and with lots of air ventilation.

Some spring flowering bulbs respond well to being planted "In the Green" That is with the leaves on, either just before, during, or after flowering, depending on your needs.

We are able to offer you a small, but comprehensive range for bulbs that prefer this method of planting. For best results, we arrange for the bulbs to be lifted a few days prior to your planting date, and it is important that you plant them as soon as possible after delivery to ensure the best results.

Availability begins in January with Eranthis and Snowdrops, and ceases in April with Native Bluebells bringing the planting season to an end.

Bulb planting tool



For the first time, we are offering long handled bulb planting tools, that you can have delivered with your bulbs. They make light work of planting "In the Green" as well as dry bulbs in uncultivated ground.

Key features: Long handle to avoid bending down and unnecessary back strain. Large ergonomic T-shape handle for better grip.

Tread-edge for controlled force and easy use. Rust resistance stainless steel head for less soil adhesion.

Shaft made from FSC® certified ash.



To bring more colour and life into the living environment, it is possible to site tubs on pavements and other pedestrian areas. It is also possible to use these tubs in streets where people regularly drive too fast. This should be undertaken in consultation with the Health & Safety, and Transport departments. During these times of attacks and threats, local government departments are taking more and more measures to prevent this kind of violence. The use of heavy weight containers planted with Bulbs and perennials, serves well to make these obstacles more pleasing on the eye, as well as beneficial to the environment, at the same time as protecting the public to a degree from such attacks.

Tubs with perennials or flower bulbs

The relevant tubs should be filled with a good combination of bulbs and perennial plants. By planting the bulbs in different layers below ground, and the correct varieties of perennials above ground, an extremely long flowering period is achievable at a relatively small cost.

Maintenance of flower tubs

With the use of tubs and containers you must take into account that in severe weather conditions bulbs can freeze. While this is not an issue for the vast majority of bulbs in the UK climate, if you use more tender bulbs such as Tazzeta Narcissi, we advise you to put the tubs close together in the winter and cover them over with fleece of blankets in periods of extreme low temperatures. As soon as the shoots appear, you can return them to their flowering position. Please bear in mind that good drainage is crucial to the success of bulbs and plants in containers.









Flowerbeds

Bulbs are well suited for planting in beds and borders. Many combinations and colour schemes are possible. If beds need to flower the same time, it is best to use bulbs of the same group, for example "Murillo", "Triumph", or "Fosteriana" Tulips. If Hyacinths are used, please specify size 15/16. Flowers may be too heavy and fall over in strong wind of heavy rain if you use much larger sizes. Likewise, if you choose smaller bulbs the flowers may be poor or weak.













Crocosmia Lucifer

The most famous and beloved bulbs are daffodils, tulips, hyacinths and crocuses. But there are many more, but less known, bulbous plants that can be used in public parks. As an example we take the Crocosmia Lucifer. This striking summer flowering (June-August) is great between covering perennials. Crocosmia Lucifer brings color to your plants and naturalizes well.





Natural planting

Natural/native plants are are usually spring flowers with striking flowers. These native plants are plants indigenous to a given area in geologic time. This includes plants that have developed, occur naturally, or existed for many years in an area

The conditions in woodland areas are not always suitable for some bulb species, so in this chapter we offer a selection of native plants and bulbs species that are ideal to use. The benefits of these species are that they self-seed easily, and they are suitable for shaded areas.











Prepared hyacinths are treated by specialist nurseries to make them flower earlier. For Christmas flowering, these bulbs must be ordered well in advance so that they can be treated accordingly. For best results we prefer to deliver them to you during mid September. You should then plant them immediately and keep them at 9°C until the bud appears. Then you should bring them into the glasshouse for finishing.







- Applicability of these terms and conditions
- Applicability of these terms and conditions
 These terms and conditions apply exclusively to agreements in which one of the parties is a member of Anthos at the time of concluding the agreement, the term term terms and conditions. The term 'memwhereby in the context of these general terms and conditions, the term 'mem-bership' also covers other companies that are directly or indirectly affiliated with a company that is a member of Anthos.
- 1.2. If an agreement refers to these terms and conditions, and only non-members are involved in that agreement, the terms and conditions set out below are not applicable.
- These terms and conditions apply to every offer and every agreement between the seller and a buyer. 1.4. The applicability of any general terms and conditions of the buyer is expressly
- rejected. Any deviations from these terms and conditions are only valid if they have 1.5.
- , en expressly agreed between the buyer and the seller 1.6. If these general terms and conditions are also drawn up in a language other
- than Dutch, the Dutch text will prevail in the case of a difference or conflict between the Dutch language and the other language.
- Offers and conclusion of an agreement
- All offers and quotations made by the seller are without obligation.
- An agreement is concluded after it has been confirmed by the seller in writing.
 Any additional agreements or changes made at a later date, as well as verbal assurances by the seller's employees or made on its behalf by its agents or other representatives, are only legally valid after they have been confirmed in writing by the seller.
- 3.1. All prices for the goods and services are quoted in Euros, excluding VAT and are based on Ex Works, the Netherlands (EXW, Incoterms 2010)
- 3.2. If one or more of the cost-determining factors changes after the order confirmation but before delivery of the goods, the seller reserves the right to adjust he agreed prices accordingly.
- The costs relating to packaging and inspection by or on behalf of the Nether-lands Food and Consumer Product Safety Authority (NVWA) are at the ex-3.3. pense of the buyer. All levies and/or taxes that are or will be due as a result of the agreement concluded by the seller with the buyer, both directly and indirectly, are exclusively and fully at the expense of the buyer
- 4.1. Unless the parties have agreed otherwise in writing, payment for sold goods that are air freighted must be made within 30 days after the invoice date and payment for sold goods that are sea freighted must be made within 60 days after the invoice date in the agreed currency.
- The date of payment is the date when the seller receives the payment. In the case of a bank transfer, the date of payment will be the value date when the 4.2. eller's bank account is credited.
- The buyer is not entitled to any deduction, suspension or payment discount; the offsetting of claims or costs is expressly not permitted. 4.3.
- If the payment term is exceeded, the seller is entitled to charge the statutory interest from the due date and all judicial and extra-judicial costs of collection 4.4
- will also be at the expense of the buyer. 4.5. If an agreement is performed in parts, the seller is entitled to demand payment for the partial deliveries before making the other partial deliveries
- 4.6. At the time of or after concluding the agreement, and before any (further) performance, the seller is entitled to demand security from the buyer that both the payment and other obligations arising from the concluded agree-ment are met. Refusal by the buyer to provide the required security entitles the seller to suspend its obligations and ultimately entitles it to, wholly or partly, terminate the agreement without formal notice or judicial intervention being required, without prejudice to its right to claim compensation for any damage suffered.
- If the agreement has legitimately been partly dissolved or suspended, the 4.7. remaining part of the agreement remains in full force, which means, among other things, that the buyer must pay the selling price of the delivered goods.
- Delivery
- Unless otherwise agreed in writing, all deliveries take place Ex Works, the Netherlands (EXW, Incoterms 2010).
- Although the specified delivery time will be taken into account as much as possible, this delivery time is only an approximation and can never be re-garded as a final deadline. The seller will not be in default with regard to the delivery time until after it has received a written notice of default from the buyer, in which the buyer has given the seller the opportunity to deliver within reasonable period and the seller has failed to do so.
- 5.3. The agreed delivery term starts as soon as the agreement has been conclu-
- The seller is not liable for damage as a result of late delivery, if and to the ex-tent that this late delivery is due to circumstances that are not for the risk and 5.4. expense of the seller, including default on the part of the seller's suppliers. The buyer's failure to comply (on time) with any payment obligation will sus-
- pend the seller's delivery obligation.
- In the event of force maieure which includes but is not limited to, crop failure, viruses, natural disasters, industrial actions, fire, import and export restrictions - and other circumstances as a result of which fulfilment of the agreement or fulfilment by the stipulated date cannot reasonably be expected from the seller, the seller will have the right, at its discretion, without judicial intervention and without being obliged to pay any compensation and by mere written notification, to either dissolve the agreement fully or partially or to suspend the performance of this agreement until the situation of force majeure has come to an end.
- Complaints
- 7.1. The buyer is obliged to check the goods upon delivery for visible and/or immediately observable defects. These are considered to be all defects that can

be detected by means of normal sensory observation or a simple random check. Furthermore, the buyer is obliged to check whether the delivered goods also comply with the order in other respects. Failure to comply with this obligation to check will result in the buyer losing any possible claims against the seller.

- If the delivered goods differ in quantity, number and weight by less than 10% from what has been agreed, the buyer will nevertheless be obliged to accept the delivered goods
- Complaints regarding the quality and quantity of the delivered goods must be submitted in writing no later than seven calendar days after delivery. Defects that can only be discovered at a later stage (hidden defects) must be notified to the seller in writing immediately after they have been discovered. As soon as these terms are exceeded, the buyer is deemed to have approved the de-livered goods and complaints will no longer be processed.
- 7.4. The complaint must contain a description of the defect and the seller must be given the opportunity to investigate the complaint upon first request. The buyer must allow the seller to have the goods in question inspected by an
- expert or an independent body. If the expert declares the complaint to be well-founded, the costs of the inspection will be at the expense of the seller. Liability

- 8.4. The buyer indemnifies the seller against claims by third parties for compensation of damages for which the seller is not liable under these terms and conditions

If the delivered goods contain latent infections, this is considered to be a non-attributable shortcoming on the part of the seller, unless the buyer proves a) that there is intent or gross negligence on the part of the seller who caused these latent infections or b) that the seller was aware of these latent infections prior to the sale, but nevertheless did not inform the buyer. The amount of seller's liability will never exceed the net invoice value.
- Cancellation
- 9.1. The seller has the right to cancel an order if, at the time of delivery, the buyer has not yet fulfilled its previous payment obligations towards the seller or towards other creditors. The seller can also exercise this right if the information concerning the buyer's creditworthiness is considered by the seller to be inadequate. The buyer cannot derive any rights from such cancellations and
- the seller can never be held liable by the buyer. 9.2. If the buyer cancels the agreement in whole or in part, as a result of whatever reason, the seller will only have to accept this if the goods have not yet been delivered to the carrier for shipment and on condition that the buyer pays compensation, which is at least equal to 25% of the invoice value of the cancelled goods. In that case, the seller will also be entitled to charge all costs incurred up to that time.
- 9.3. The buyer is obliged to take delivery of the goods at the moment when they are made available to the buyer. If the buyer refuses to do so, the seller is entitled to sell these goods elsewhere and the buyer will be liable for the price difference as well as for all other costs incurred by the seller as a result, . including storage costs.
- Reservation of title
- 10.1. Title to the goods delivered by the seller does not transfer to the buyer until after full payment of all amounts invoiced by the seller plus any interest, penalties and costs as well as settlement of all claims arising from shortcomings on the part of the buyer in meeting its obligations arising from agreements with the seller.
- 10.2. The seller is entitled to immediately take back the sold goods if the buyer is in default in any way or fails to meet its payment obligation. In that case, the buyer is obliged to grant the seller access to its grounds and buildings. 10.3. The buyer must store the goods that are subject to a reservation of title sepa
- rately from the other goods in order to be able to continue to distinguish the seller's goods.
- 10.4. As long as the delivered goods are subject to a reservation of title, the buye may not dispose, encumber, pledge or otherwise place them under the con-trol of third parties outside the scope of its normal business operations. However, the buyer is not permitted to alienate the goods as part of its normal business operations, at the time when the buyer has requested a suspension of payments or when the buyer has been declared bankrupt.

Sanctions

11.1. The buyer guarantees that it complies with and will continue to comply with the obligations and limitations that ensue from all applicable sanction regulations of the United Nations, the United States of America, the European Union, the Netherlands and of any other country that is or may become relevant for the execution of the agreement that has been concluded ("Sanctions Legislation").

- 11.2. In particular, the buyer guarantees that it will not directly or indirectly sell, transfer, supply or otherwise make the purchased goods available to natural
 or legal persons, entities, groups or public-sector or other organisations that
 have been sanctioned pursuant to the Sanctions Legislation.
 11.3. The buyer ensures that all obligations from this article will be imposed equal-
- ly on every party to which it sells on or supplies goods that it bought from the seller
- 11.4. If the buyer fails to comply with the obligations that ensue for it from this article, or fails to comply with them in a prompt or proper manner, the seller is entitled to suspend or terminate the agreement immediately without further notice of default, without being obliged to pay any compensation for damage and with the buyer being fully liable for compensation vis-à-vis the seller, at the seller's discretion

Anti-Corruption

- 12.1. The buver will at all times comply with the obligations and limitations that ensue from all applicable anti-corruption regulations of the United States of America, the United Kingdom, the Netherlands and of any other country that is or may become relevant for the execution of the agreement that has been
- concluded ("Anti-Corruption Legislation"). 12.2. Each offer to and each acceptance by employees or members of the client's board of money, gifts, presents, trips, entertainment or other compensation that relates to the agreement or the seller and that is intended as, or can be seen as, an incentive to act in a certain way is strictly prohibited.
- 12.3. The client will make not offer, promise or give anything directly or indirectly to any political party, campaign, government agency, officer or public institutions, state-run enterprises, organisations, international institutions, or their employees, with the purpose of acquiring or retaining goods or any other improper advantage in connection with the agreement or the seller. 12.4. In connection with the agreement or the seller, the buyer will not offer, pro-
- mise or give anything to or accept anything from a business client, unless there is an honest reason to do so and it is reasonable to do so in the context of the daily course of affairs and, moreover, complies with local legislation.
- 12.5. The buyer will inform the seller immediately if, in the execution of the agree ment, it takes note of any situation that may be in conflict with the Anti-Corruption Legislation.
- 12.6. If the buyer fails to comply with the obligations that ensue for it from this article, or fails to comply with them in a prompt or proper manner, the seller is entitled to suspend or terminate the agreement immediately without further notice of default, without being obliged to pay any compensation for damage and with the buyer being fully liable for compensation vis-à-vis the seller, at the seller's discretion.

Dissolution and suspension

- 13.1. In the event that the buyer fails to fulfil, fails to fulfil on time or fails to fulfil properly the obligations that have arisen from the concluded agreement, or f there is a well-founded fear of this, as well as in the event of an application for suspension of payments, bankruptcy or liquidation of the buyer's goods as well as in the event of the buyer's death or if the buyer is a company, its dissolution or termination, or if there is a change in its corporate form or in the management of the company or in the activities to which the company contributes, the seller has the right, without notice of default and without judicial intervention, to suspend the agreement for a reasonable term or to dissolve the agreement without any obligation to pay damages
- 13.2. The seller's claim in respect of the already performed part of the agreement, as well as the damage resulting from the suspension or dissolution, including loss of profit, will be immediately due and payable.

Intellectual property rights

- 14.1. The seller reserves all rights that the seller has concerning intellectual proper-ty in connection with goods delivered by the seller.
 14.2. In those cases where it appears from the seller's catalogue or the agreement
- concluded by the parties that a variety is protected by plant breeder's rights - which is indicated by an (R) after the name of the variety in question - the buyer will be bound by all obligations relating to that right. Violation of this provision means that the buyer will be liable for all damage incurred by the seller and third parties as a result.

Conflicts with legal provisions 15.

Should any provision of these General Terms and Conditions of Sale and Delivery be non-applicable or in conflict with public order or legislation, then only the relevant provision will be considered as not being written, but the other conditions will remain fully in force.

The seller reserves the right to change the challenged provision into a legally valid one.

Competent court/applicable law

- 16.1. These terms and conditions and all offers made by the seller and agreements between the buyer and the seller are governed exclusively by the law of the Netherlands. The applicability of the Vienna Convention ('the United Nations Convention on Contracts for the International Sale of Goods' (CISG) is expressly excluded.
- 16.2. All disputes that may arise between the seller and the buyer, even those considered as such by only one of the parties, will be settled exclusively by the court that has jurisdiction in the area in which the seller has its registered office, without prejudice to the seller's right to submit the dispute to the court that has jurisdiction in the location where the buyer has its registered office.
